Work Schedule:

MANDATORY REQUIREMENTS:

One-Hour long virtual weekly team meeting

Options: Tues 7:30am, 9:00am, Tues 1030am, Tues 1200pm

AND

Bi-weekly position specific virtual coaching sessions held under the supervision of a supervisor.

February 3rd to April 15th check your schedule prior to applying.

Work hours are flexible, but you must commit to working 10-20 hours per week.

Applicants must reside in Texas and be a US Citizen or have work authorization approved prior to applying.

Responsibilities Include:

- Discuss and identify the interests and needs regarding the event, product, program, or service
- Discuss, agree on, and plan the campaign messaging, visuals, action, consider keywords for SEO
- Manage the website updates
- Create an online course, review, test, revise, finalize
- Analyze and measure the website activity (feedback, data, analytics, sales, other)
- Create and make recommendations on how to adjust/improve the website
- Write a wrap-up report

Qualifications:

- Proficiency in writing, verbal, proofreading, editing, and email communication is required

- Detail-oriented, with ability to work under deadlines
- Self-starter willing to learn
- Understanding of or prior work/volunteer experience in non-profit organizations is a plus
- Familiarity with web design software (such as Wordpress, Elementor, Learndash, Wix and Adobe) is a plus

In this internship program, the intern will learn how to take skills they have acquired in school or former job experiences and apply them in a professional setting. They will gain a better understanding of the role can play in a non-profit setting and be better prepared to work in the arena of operations and the nonprofit sector.
